All

- Attendance: Due to the state closing all schools in the state for the year. We are no longer keeping track of attendance.
- Enrichment: Our desire is for parents and students to thrive during this time. For that reason we are offering the following enrichment activities which are completely optional.
 - O Daily story time with Miss Gwen | 3pm
 - O Bi-Weekly chapel with Mr. Burkholder | Wed and Fri | 9am
- **Communication:** Parents are responsible for contacting their student's homeroom teacher with any questions. Teachers will communicate to parent's the amount of work required in order to pass the grade.
- Assignments: Homeroom teachers will assign content for every day of the school closure. These assignments will be communicated daily or weekly in written form based on what the homeroom teachers deem to be most effective. The amount of work assigned will be adjusted according to the amount needing to be completed.

K through 2nd Grade

- **Tests:** Tests will be administered according to teacher's discretion.
- **Grades:** We will keep track of student's test scores for the sake of our records, but at this point plan to give Pass/Fail grades for all assignments during the 4th quarter.

3rd through 12th Grade

- Scoring Work: Students will need to follow normal classroom procedures with scoring.
 Upon reaching a "score strip" students are to call their homeroom teacher and score their work remotely. Checkups and Self Tests can be taken at home after receiving a verbal affirmation from their homeroom teacher.
- Tests: Tests will be administered via Zoom video conferencing.

- **Grades:** We will give scores as we have been. For high schooler we will note on the transcript about the pandemic.
- Virtual classes: Tests will be administered according to teacher's discretion.
