Before answering questions on notebook paper, divide the paper into two columns. Some answers come from the book *Doctrines of the* Bible. Reading every word in that book is not required. However, before asking classmates for help, carefully read any indicated pages and indicated verses. If a page number or verse is listed after a question, the answer should come from that page or verse. To answer some questions may require reading the Bible. It should not shock us if at times we do not feel like studying the Bible – for we have an enemy who does not want us to take the sword of the Spirit and fight "against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Eph 6:12). As we study the word of God, may we allow it to accomplish in our lives what God wants it to accomplish – for "blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it" (Lk 11:28). As God speaks to us, may we not harden our hearts. Instead, may we make all the changes He asks of us (even the uncomfortable ones).
